# STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE: GO FOR IT!



## 1. Register as a teacher/designer Create your account.

From your dashboard, you will have access to:

- Activity creation
- Group management
- Student tracking



## 3. Creating student groups

You can:

- Create classes or cohorts
- Generate access codes.
- Invite participants without the an institutional email address.

This is ideal for:

- Pilot workshops
- Boot camps
- Training of trainers
- Testing of materials



## 2. Creating a micro-activity

You can design short activities such as:

- Interactive questions
- Decision scenarios
- Mini-challenges
- Multimedia activities
- Step-by-step sequences

Each activity is built following the logic of brief learning objectives, short interaction and immediate feedback.



## 4. Assigning activities

You associate activities with each group.

Students access them using the code and complete the micro-activities on the web or mobile.



## 5. Monitoring and analytics

From your dashboard, you can see:

- Who completed each activity
- Response results
- Time spent
- Overall progress of the group

This allows you to evaluate the effectiveness of the design, adjust activities and detect learning difficulties.
